The Lordstown Local School District is an outstanding public school with a great history. Our K-12 enrollment totals 516 which includes open enrollment from many districts in the Mahoning Valley. Lordstown Elementary houses grades K-6 and the High School houses grades 7-12. Lordstown Schools has a staff of 43 licensed/ certified teaching professionals. Our student/teacher ratio is approximately 12:1.

Students at the High School have the opportunity to take College Credit Plus courses from local colleges as well as in the LHS building through Youngstown State University. New in 2015-2016 we are offering our students an ACT prep course taught by our content experts. Junior and Senior students also have the option of pursuing a vocational or tech prep education at the Trumbull Career & Technical Center.

We offer a wealth of Extracurricular activities including Lego League, Prep Bowl, Key Club, Power of the Pen and Mock Trial. In addition to these and many other activities, our students in grades 7-12 have many opportunities to compete athletically on school sports teams governed by the Ohio High School Athletic Association.
